

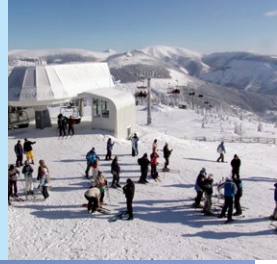
Activities



1 Town Trails – cross-country ski track “Bud’ fit” (Be Fit), leads along the Elbe river towards the Pudlava river and to Pudlava Waterfall. Length: 8 km. Convenient also for families with children. For walkers are Miller Trails (Mlýnský okruh) divided by the color, length and content. In winter only individual passage (circuits are not edited). Trout Trail leads through the town centre.



2 Ski Resort St. Peter – Cable Way of St. Peter – Plán (1,098 m above sea level); blue, red and black signed FIS downhill tracks with the connection to Hromovka Ski Resort, where it is possible to use 1,500 m long, red signed downhill track for night skiing. The downhill tracks are equipped with modern technical snowing. Cross-country ski tracks in Pláně, altogether 24 km. In St. Peter Resort there is Snowpark, including Half Pipe and in Hromovka there is Funtrack – to liven up the skiing for both children and adults. Snack is available in the restaurant with outside terrace in: Na Pláni, Apres Ski Bar St. Peter and in Hromovka, in the restaurant in St. Peter at the finish area of downhill tracks. Multifunctional building at the lower cableway station offers cash desks, information centre, sport and fashion clothes shop, ski and snowboard equipment rental, ski school. Skibus – stations Hromovka and St. Peter Ski Resort. Parking at Hromovka Cableway free of charge.



3 Medvědin Ski Resort – Medvědin Cableway (1,235 m above sea level) – Horní Mísečky; wide downhill tracks of all categories on the south-facing slopes, ideal for beginners, children and advanced skiers too. Connection to Labská Cableway. Funtrack – new in Horní Mísečky. Medvědin is also ideal starting point for cross-country skiers, walkers and skialpinists going to mountain tours on Giant Mountains ridges – connection to Giant Mountains Ski Trail (Krkonošská magistrála). Cross-country ski racing tracks are part of Horní Mísečky Resort. Snack in restaurant at both the lower and upper cableway stations of Medvědin and in Horní Mísečky. Skibus – stop at the lower cableway station. Parking in Medvědin and in Horní Mísečky free of charge.



4 Stoh Ski Resort – snowed resort, ski tracks being adjusted daily. Downhill track length: 1,200 m. Skiing both for beginners and professionals (children moving walkway, Poma ski tow, T-bar), common checkout system with St. Peter Ski Resort, Medvědin, Labská, Horní Mísečky. Ski and Snowboard School. Snack in restaurant (both indoor and outdoor). Parking at the piste free of charge. Skibus - station Stoh.



5 Bobsleigh Run – is 1.4 km long, with 22 bends, 5 terrain edges and 3 tunnels. This run offers beautiful panoramas. All-season operation. Children under 8 years only with parental guidance.



6 Water Parks – relaxation in pleasant setting, whirlpool bath, sauna, steam, massage. Children swimming pools, water slides.



7 Sledging Run – by bus from the town centre up to Špindlerova bouda mountain hut, going down back on the sledge. Length 4 km. Start 1,150 m above sea level, altitude difference 350 m. Day and night rides.



8 Ski Alpinism – ski alpine tracks available. Planning and track choice should be always in accordance with experience level and equipment. Tracks are divided according to difficulty: blue – orientation-challenging terrain; red – avalanche terrain; purple – both orientation-challenging and avalanche terrain; black – other notifications and/or steep mountain terrain. For higher security it is possible to hire a mountain guide.



9 Ice Rink – public ice rink with natural ice and evening lighting. Appreciated by both children and adults.



10 Kids Ski Park – public children ski parks, convenient for small skiers – beginners



11 Snowtubing – on rubber boats through 200 m long snow bed.



12 Cross-country Quads – organised trips on quads to the surroundings of Špindlerův Mlýn.

13 Other activities – indoor tennis, indoor golf, wellness, minigolf, scooter rentals, squash, paragliding, snowkiting, bowling, archery, horse riding, camping, ski and snowboard schools, rentals etc.



Špindlerův Mlýn

Špindlerův Mlýn is the most popular and frequented centre of our highest mountains – the Giant Mountains (Krkonoše). Extraordinary climatic conditions, the town altitude of 710 – 850 meters above sea level and convenient setting satisfy visitors seeking for sports, hiking, active way of spending free time and relaxation throughout the whole year.

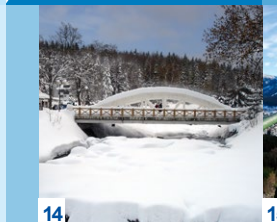

Interesting places



14 White Bridge
(Bílý most)

– dominant architectonic feature of Špindlerův Mlýn connecting both sides of the Elbe River directly in the town centre. The bridge was built on a kind of crossroads in 1911. The right bank of the town is thus connected with Bedřichov, which was an independent village till the year 1942. In 19th century it belonged to domain of Jilemnice. The left side used to be under the control of the count family of Morzin. The bridge is 27.6 m long; the street part width of the bridge is 4.84 m. There is no central counterfort. The bridge arch is 3.65 m high at its highest point.



15 Harrach Rock
(Harrachova skála)

– you can find it on the blue marked hiking trail on the way from Horní Mísečky back to Špindlerův Mlýn or on the Bear's Path. It is a rock outcrop on the hillside of Mechovinec mountain, which reaches the height of 1,074 m above sea level. From Mechovinec mountain there is wonderful view of the Špindlerův Mlýn valley and surrounding panoramas. The outlook site was built up by the Czech Tourist Club in 1893. The place was named after the supporter of the above mentioned club the Count of Harrach.



16 Chapel of St. Francis of Assisi
(Kaplička sv. Františka z Assisi)

– is situated below Malý Šišák hill at the newly reconstructed Erlebachova bouda mountain hut. In 2007 this chapel was consecrated by the priest Jiří Šlégr and the bell comes from the workshop of Marie Tomášková-Dytrchová. At the occasion of St. Francis holy day on 4th October there are pilgrimages to this place and a feast takes place at Erlebachova bouda hut.



17 St. Peter's Church
(Kostel sv. Petra)

– town dominant since the beginning of 19th century. Its foundation stone was laid in 1802 and then consecrated in 1807. This church remained in original classicism style without any considerable rearrangements until these days. It was built to replace the chapel in St. Peter town part. The church bell comes from the original chapel. It has a typical high sound, which is supposed to be caused by the significant silver content. There is a Christ's Last Supper Chapel near this place.



18 Hanč and Vrbata Monument
(Mohyla Hanče a Vrbaty)

– is situated above Vrbatova bouda mountain hut and memorializes tragic event of 24th March 1913. There was a 50 km long cross-country skiing contest during which participant Bohumil Hanč and his friend Václav Vrbata died in snow storm. The story of Hanč and Vrbata became a symbol of great heroism and friendship.



19 Snow Mountain
(Sněžka)

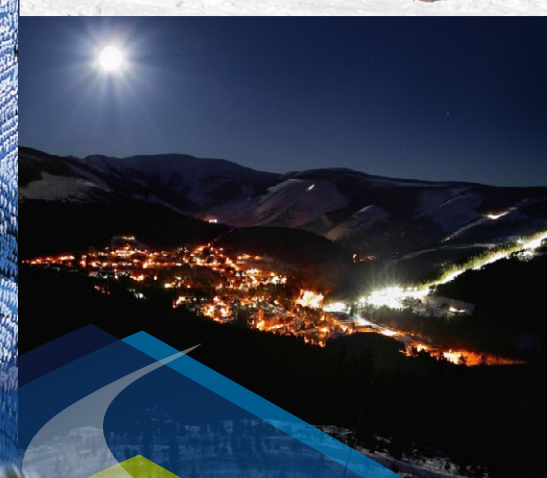
– the highest mountain of the Czech Republic is situated 1,602 m above sea level. Travel description: Špindlerův Mlýn, Svätý Petr (St. Peter), Stará Bucharova cesta (Old Bucharova Way), Kozí hřbety (Goat Ridges), outlook 4.5 km, Luční bouda (Meadow Hut) 6.5 km, Slezská bouda (Silesian Hut) (PL) 9.5 km, Sněžka (Snow Mountain) 11 km. To simplify the way it is possible to use cableway to Pláně, and bus to Špindlerova bouda mountain hut.



20 Elbe Dam
(Labská přehrada)

– is a technical monument. It was named after the settlement with similar name, built 1910 - 1916. Basic technical data: gravity arch dam of "Intze" type, dam crest dimension: 694.16 m above sea level, dam length in crest: 153,5 m, dam width in crest: 6,15 m, am height above the foundation: 41,5 m, emergency spillway dimension: 691,26 m, total dam capacity: 2,9155 mil. m³, maximal flooded area: 23,6 hectares, catchment area: 60,54 km², average flow rate: 2,14 m³/s, hundred-year flood: 175,0 m³/s.

Špindlerova bouda Hut

– the Big and Small Snow Pits are divided from each other by a rock ridge. The Small Snow Pit is 550 m long, 400 m wide and 300 m deep. The Big Snow Pit on the eastern slope is 800 m long, 600 m wide and 300 m high. On the bottom there are glacial lakes Sněžné Stawki and Mlaka. The rock next to Wawel hut is highest situated tor of the Giant Mountains – 1,490 m above sea level. It is interesting there are different names for it in different languages. In Czech it is called the Ambo of Krakonoš (Krakonošova kazatelna), in Polish: Devil's Ambo (Czarcia Ambona) and in German: the Office of Krakonoš (Rübezahls Kanzel). Travel description: Špindlerův Mlýn, Medvědin, Vrbatovo návrší, Pramen Labe (Elbe Source), Violík, Sněžné jámy (Snow Pits), Labská bouda (Elbe Hut), Vrbatovo návrší, Horní Mísečky, Špindlerův Mlýn. To simplify the way it is possible to use the cableway to Medvědin. Altogether 25 km.

– 71 km long cross-country ski trail leading through the Giant Mountains, from Harachov up to Žacléř. It is divided into stages: Giant Mountains Ski Trail – red signage. Blue signage – racing tracks. Green signage – tourist tracks. Possibility of connection to Giant Mountains Ski Trail from Špindlerův Mlýn: direction West Giant Mountains (západní Krkonoše) – Medvědin, East Giant Mountains (východní Krkonoše) – St. Peter.



– the Elbe is one of the biggest European rivers, its source is situated 1,386 m above sea level. Travel description: Špindlerův Mlýn Square, direction Bedřichov, Horní Mísečky, Vrbatova bouda (Vrbata Hut), pramen Labe (the Elbe Source), Labská bouda (Elbe Hut), Hanč and Vrbata Monument, Sviňské louže, Medvědin, Špindlerův Mlýn. Altogether 21 km. To simplify the way, it is possible to use the cableway to Medvědin.

– are located on the Polish side of the Giant Mountains below the Czech-Polish Friendship Trail, on the stage from Polední kameny (Noon Stones) to the place where the yellow marked Slezská cesta (Silesian Trail) or Janova cesta (Jan's Trail) joins. Velký Stav Lake lies 1,225 m above sea level, its surface numbers 6.5 hectares and the depth 23 metres. Malý Stav Lake is situated 1,183 metres above sea level, its surface numbers 2.9 hectares and its depth is only 6.5 metres. Water of both of the lakes is amber coloured and with its physical characteristics is similar to alpine lakes. Travel description: Špindlerův Mlýn, bus up to Špindlerova bouda mountain hut, the Czech-Polish Friendship Trail, Polední kameny (Noon Stones) at the altitude of 1,006 metres above sea level, Velký and Malý Stav Lakes, Luční bouda (Meadow Hut), Výrovka (Eagle Owl Hut), St. Peter, Špindlerův Mlýn. Altogether 16 km.

– was built by the Count Jan Nepomuk František Harrach in 1836. The original wooden building was replaced by a steel construction with a 15 m high lookout tower in 1889. Present stone building with its 18 m high lookout tower comes from 1892 and is the only lookout tower made of stone in the Giant Mountains. Travel description: Špindlerův Mlýn, Horní Mísečky, Janova Hora, Rovinka, Benecko, Zadní Žalý, Přední Žalý – lookout tower. Way back: via Třidomí, town part of Špindlerův Mlýn Labská (Krausovy boudy mountain huts) to Špindlerův Mlýn. Altogether 22.5 km.

– is the oldest part of Špindlerův Mlýn and a valley with idyllic views. Copper and silver mines from the 16th century are nowadays closed. Travel description: Špindlerův Mlýn, Sv. Petr (St. Peter) 3 km. It is possible to continue in direction Výrovka (Eagle Owl Hut), Luční bouda (Meadow Hut), or to Dvorská bouda hut and Klínové boudy huts.

– starting point for high altitude hiking. Destinations: Luční bouda (Meadow Hut), Martinova bouda (Martin Hut), Velký and Malý Stav Lakes, Pec pod Sněžkou, Karpacz, Kowary, Labská bouda (The Elbe Hut), pramen Labe (the Elbe Source). Transport to Špindlerova bouda hut: town public transport from Špindlerův Mlýn centre, skibus.
